

## **DANCE & GYMNASTIC ATTIRE**

Proper dance attire is required for all classes. Jeans are not allowed in class as well as baggy or oversized clothes. Tights must be worn under shorts. Tap and pink ballet shoes are necessary for regular class. The color of tap shoes depends on the level of class. Black jazz shoes are required for jazz and hip hop students. A leotard is required for gymnastic tumbling and gymnastic apparatus students. No jewelry is allowed and long hair must be tied back. Tights are not worn for gymnastics. A Regulation Uniform is required for Sunday Team classes.

## **ATTENDANCE**

When you register your child for class, you are paying for your child's guaranteed place in class, not their attendance. Obviously, we cannot be responsible for your child's attendance. We do not pro-rate, refund, or carry forward fees for a child's failure to attend class.

## **AWARDS**

Awards are given at the recital and gym show to students who have completed 4, 5, 10, 15, or 20 years of dance or gymnastics with C.S.P.A.

## **COSTUMES/LEOTARDS**

Costume information is included in your Fall Packet. For your convenience, partial payments will be accepted beginning in September. Full payment for costumes must be received by December 31. Leotard payments are due by March 1st. No refunds will be given once costumes and leotards are ordered. Tuition accounts must be paid in full for recital and gym show participation

## **INSURANCE**

Due to the difficulties caused by insurance company requirements, the Children's Studio will be unable to arrange Student Medical Insurance. All parents are urged to review their insurance coverage to be sure that medical and hospital coverage exists on your child.

## **PICK UP & DROP OFF**

Please be sure to bring your child into class and pick up your child on time inside the studio. We do not allow students to wait outside the studio for their parents. If you have an emergency and cannot pick your child up on time, please notify the instructor.

**DANCE & GYMNASTIC SEASON**

The 2020-21 season will begin on Monday, August 24, 2020 and run until our recital which is to be determined in May. C.S.P.A. will close select holidays. Please refer to our studio calendar for exact dates.

Parents may view their child's progress: Dance- beginning of each month and Gymnastics- open door policy. We do ask that you supervise siblings who are not in the class. Parents should not talk to, "coach" or in any way distract a student or instructor's attention while class is in session. The instructor reserves the right to limit class viewing if it becomes a distraction.

**REGISTRATION FEE**

Registration Fee is \$30.00 per student or \$35.00 per family and must be paid when registering.

**PAYMENT POLICIES**

Tuition payments are collected on a ten payment basis. To hold your child's place in class, tuition must be paid on time. No child will be allowed back in class until tuition is brought up to date. Payments can be handed to your child's teacher in a sealed envelope or they can be mailed to: **C.S.P.A., 71 Oxford Road, Oxford, CT 06478**. All checks returned by the bank are subject to a \$20.00 returned check fee.

**WITHDRAWAL FROM CLASS**

Withdrawal from class must be done by calling the main office, 203-888-6516. **We do not consider a student withdrawn unless the office is notified directly.** You will continue to be billed for lessons until you officially withdraw your child from class with the office. No further payment is expected beyond the month of withdrawal.

**MAKE-UP CLASSES**

Studio policy regarding inclement weather is as follows: Cancelled lessons will be made up at a future date. Cancelled lessons will be posted at Channel 8, a message on the studio phone (203.888.6516) and on the CSPFA Facebook page. We do not promise or owe make-up classes unless we cancel the class. Make-up dates for classes cancelled due to weather will be scheduled and notices sent by the office, through the student to the parent, as to day and time. When a make-up class is scheduled, we consider the class made-up regardless of whether the child attends or not.
